SO BRILLIANT dueled between horses then outside the runner-up into and on the turn and in the stretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole and inched away under urging late. DOYOUSEEMECONING sped to the early lead, dueled inside rivals but just off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, fought back off the inside in the drive but could not match the winner late. GLADDING bobbled at the start but recovered and prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail into and on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. HIGH TEST chased inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn, swung out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AMERICAN ACT saved ground chasing the pace throughout and weakened in the final furlong. BANK THE EIGHT chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and did not rally.
