Footnotes

HADFUNLASTNIGHT stalked inside then bid along the rail a half mile out to press the pace, fell back on the turn, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past the eighth pole, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and proved best under urging. SECRET SPY had speed outside then dueled three deep, battled outside a rival leaving the turn, inched away nearing midstretch, fought back inside the winner, could not match that one late but held second. FIST PUMP stalked three deep then outside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and continued willingly to best the others. J J'S JAGUAR stalked outside the winner then bid between horses a half mile out, dueled inside on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ALREADY THERE saved ground chasing the pace throughout and did not rally in the stretch. SILVER RATE pulled his way between horses and steadied a half mile out, dropped back into and on the turn, gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
