Footnotes

JOHN JOHNY JAK stalked the pace inside, came out some in the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and won clear, then broke down around the clubhouse turn while pulling up and was vanned off. OBVIOUSLY (IRE) between horses early, pulled his way up three deep then stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, could not match the winner but was second best. COMMA TO THE TOP had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back in the stretch and just held third. GREAT WARRIOR (BRZ) chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and just missed the show. GALLANT SON four wide early, chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RAUSCHENBERG bobbled at the start, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. VICTORY PETE stalked between horses then outside a rival, continued off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch was between foes in midstretch and weakened. DANCING IN SILKS angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn, was in a bit tight between horses while dropping back nearing midstretch and weakened.
