WARRENS VENEDALUCY unhurried inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and wore down that rival late under urging. HUNTINGTON HARBOUR had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. ZEES CHRIS was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and bested the others. CEE'S THE YEAR saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GRASP well placed stalking the pace inside, pulled her way into a tight spot a half mile out, continued inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. PARDON MY EXCESS had speed between horses then dueled inside the runner-up but off the rail, angled in passing the half mile pole, fought back along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WARREN'S SAMANTHA allowed to settle outside a rival chasing the pace, was between horses leaving the turn, dropped back into the stretch and lacked a further response.
