Footnotes

RUSSEL'S RUN stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, bid four wide at the quarter pole, took the lead three deep into the stretch, kicked clear and held under urging. LOVMEISTER broke slowly, settled off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and finished well. ERIC THE RAM stalked the pace inside, slipped through while in tight a quarter mile out and again into the stretch and held third. MAYAN EYES stumbled badly at the start, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. TALK THE WALK stalked three deep or outside the winner, went three wide on the turn, bid five wide a quarter mile out and four wide into the stretch and weakened. CORI CELESTI had good early speed and angled in, dueled outside a rival, was between horses leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and also weakened. MANDELIEU angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, was between horses a quarter mile out, was in a bit tight into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
