Footnotes

TIZOUTTASIGHT broke a bit slowly and bobbled slightly, settled between horses then just off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and rallied under urging to get up three deep late. EXPONENTIALLY had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, inched away into the stretch and held on well but was caught nearing the wire. MOSSO dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued off the rail in midstretch then came back on between foes late. ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN prompted the pace three deep to the stretch and weakened. B. B.'S BANDMAN bumped at the start, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BLACK TIE broke a bit slowly and bumped with a rival, was sent inside early, saved ground throughout and was not a threat. LAPUA broke outward and a bit slowly, settled three deep on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. TENACITY had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CHARLIE THOMAS was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, drifted out through the drive and weakened.
