JIM'S DECISION had speed outside rivals then angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, inched away nearing the second turn, drifted out a bit then inward in the stretch but won clear under some urging and steady handling. TEMERITY chased off the rail, came three wide into the stretch, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. JOE CARL allowed to settle along the inside, saved ground throughout and picked up the show. ROYAL IMPORT (GB) unhurried outside a rival for six furlongs, was in a bit tight into the stretch and lacked a rally. ROCK THIS WAY stalked off the rail then bid alongside the winner to press the pace, stalked off the inside into and on the second turn, drifted out some in upper stretch and gave way.
