SMART AND SINGLE in a bit tight between foes early, chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and won clear under some urging. PRINCESS ASH sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. GOLDEN PRODUCTION stalked outside a rival or between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail leaving the turn and bested the others. MISS MALIBU chased outside, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed rally. MINDS EYES a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then three deep leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. EPONIA also broke a bit slowly, settled off the fence then outside a rival, continued off the inside on the turn and was not a threat. MADERA DANCER allowed to settle off the pace inside, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. HELLO BROADWAYDOLL saved ground stalking the pace on the backstretch and turn and weakened. COTTON BELLE between foes early, stalked three deep, dropped back on the turn and into the stretch and gave way.
