BAROCCI (JPN) angled in and stalked just off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, went three deep into the second turn, bid outside the runner-up on that bend, had that one slip away into the stretch, re-bid under left handed urging past midstretch, gained the advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. COMPARI had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, responded when challenged again on the second turn, slipped away into the stretch, fought back past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. OLD TIME HOCKEY pulled and angled in into the first turn, lugged out a bit on the backstretch, went between foes leaving the backstretch then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. BLUESKIESRAINBOWS dueled outside the runner-up then stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and between foes on the second turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch. TEMPLE'S DOOR saved ground chasing the pace, moved up some on the backstretch, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. ASHTAR (CHI) came off the rail on the first turn, went up three deep on the backstretch then four wide into the second turn, dropped back on that turn, angled in some and weakened.
