Footnotes

TOM'S TRIBUTE had speed outside and dueled alongside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, fought back under left handed urging while drifting out a bit when challenged by the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. IMPERIAL FORTUNE broke inward, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid outside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly but could not quite match that one late. OKAAD between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out in midstretch and got up for the show late. MIDNITE VIEW bobbled a step out of the gate, was three deep early then chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and just missed third. DEPUTY STRIKER had speed off the rail then angled in and dueled a bit off the fence to the stretch and weakened. MI HIJO stalked inside then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. SPECTRUS between horses early, settled inside, came out on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
