Footnotes

MISSDEALORNODEAL pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, took command and drew out in the final furlong under hand urging. ENTABENI was sent to the lead coming out of the chute, set the pace on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides with the winner in upper stretch, but held the place on the inside at the wire. PICTURE PERFECT (IRE) chased the pace off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside into the turn, saved ground around the turn, swung out for the stretch drive, rallied three deep and was edged for the place on the wire. RISKY ART (GB) stalked the pace outside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the lane three wide and could not mount the necessary rally while between horses at the wire. TRAPPER'S REWARD stalked the pace inside a rival down the backstretch and around the turn, remained inside through the drive and weakened in the final furlong. QUIET ADVICE chased the pace from behind, angled to the inside midway down the backstretch, saved some ground around the turn but did not offer a bid in the lane.
