GAME ON DUDE angled in and forced the pace outside a rival, took the lead approaching the five eighths pole, inched away into the second turn, kicked clear and angled in on that turn and held on gamely under some left handed urging. RICHARD'S KID a bit awkwardly into stride, settled just off the rail, went outside a rival on the backstretch, advanced three deep into the second turn then alongside a foe leaving that turn, continued willingly in the stretch but could not catch the winner. KETTLE CORN settled a bit off the rail then inside, split horses into the second turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. SPUD SPIVENS angled in and took the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, stalked the winner into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. LOVE THEWAY YOUARE saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and was not a threat. ANTHONY'S CROSS pulled his way along to chase the pace outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET stalked a bit off the rail then inside, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
