Footnotes

JUSTA RUNNER had speed inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and inched away and held on gamely under urging. KILL SHOT prompted the pace outside then three deep leaving the backstretch and outside the winner on the turn, battled between rivals leaving the turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but held second. HOLY LUTE stalked outside then four wide leaving the backstretch, bid three deep a quarter mile out and bested the others. STORM POWER between horses early, chased off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PROVEN WARRIOR went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. YE CALL ME CHIEF had speed between foes to force or stalk the pace, bumped with a rival and steadied in tight into the turn, continued just off the rail on the bend and weakened. CUNEO chased outside, steadied and was forced out into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. TRYFAN was sent between horses to stalk the pace, went between foes again into the turn and steadied then clipped heels to fall back and weakened. KIBOU had speed between horses to press then stalk the pace, bumped with a rival and steadied in very tight quarters into the turn to fall back, continued a bit off the rail and had little left for the stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident entering the turn but made no change when they ruled no one runner could be held responsible for the trouble.
