ARRAIGNMENT stalked outside a rival then just off the rail, came out into the stretch, bid under urging three deep in midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. ANTIDOTE prompted the pace outside a rival, fought back between horses through a long drive and edged a foe for the place. ROBBIE'S WAR settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and found his best stride late outside. THE WHAMMER sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set a pressured pace inside, fought back along the rail through the stretch and was edged late for the show. TROPICAL HEAT angled in and chased between horses then outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. ERIC THE RAM broke out a bit, pulled his way along and steadied into the first turn, stalked inside to the stretch and weakened. HASTY TREND four wide early, chased three deep, dropped back leaving the second turn, angled in some into the stretch and also weakened.
