SHE'S A TIGER dueled outside a rival, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held sway under a tap of the whip and steady handling while being flagged with the stick until the final stages. E EQUALSMCSQUARED settled outside a rival then off the rail, went outside a foe on the turn and three deep into the stretch and finished well. PLEASANT MISS stalked the pace off the rail, was between horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and went willingly to the wire for the show. PERCHED unhurried off the rail early, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and bested the others. GAGAVERYOU stalked the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, was three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. ON THE BACKSTREETS saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. SOUTH SOUND had good early speed and dueled inside the winner, stalked leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
