**Footnotes**

DEVGRU sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the turn, inched away under urging in the stretch and drew clear. A. P. CORSAIR sent between horses then dropped back off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, moved up inside then came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place. DANGER LURKING settled off the rail then three deep leaving the backstretch, continued off the inside on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and edged rivals late for third. MINISTER OF TRADE stalked five wide then off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid outside the winner on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MARY'S APP pulled some and stalked four wide between foes, steadied leaving the backstretch, remained four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. GOLD EXPRESSION stalked off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the turn and weakened in the drive. OFFICER BAVETTA stalked the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn and also weakened in the lane. SKULLY GULLY pulled his way along to stalk between rivals on the backstretch and turn and also weakened in the stretch. WARREN'S BIG GOLD came out just after the start, settled between rivals then off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. SACRED GHOST broke a bit slowly then steadied just after the start, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail.
