Footnotes

ALBERTS HOPE had speed outside then stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes in midstretch, gained the advantage under left handed urging past the sixteenth pole and gamely prevailed. BAJAN stalked inside, waited briefly off heels past midstretch, split rivals a sixteenth out and continued willingly. RUM POINT dueled inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back inside in the drive and held third. AMERICAN PRIDE dueled outside a rival, was floated out a bit into the stretch, put a head in front between foes in midstretch, battled back between horses in the final furlong and was edged for the show. DECISIVE MIND chased between horses, steadied briefly in tight off heels into the turn, angled to the inside leaving the bend and lacked the needed rally. UNCHARTED COURSE chased three deep between horses then outside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. COMMON CONFUSION a bit slow to begin, chased the pace a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. DANCE WITH FATE broke slowly, trailed off the rail then pulled his way between horses leaving the backstretch, angled in some on the turn and lacked a rally. HEYYOUCAN chased four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn, angled to the inside entering the stretch and weakened.
