SEQUOIA WARRIOR dueled three deep between foes on the backstretch, battled between horses on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, took a short lead, fought back inside the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. FIRST STRIKE broke a bit slowly, was three deep early then pulled his way up four wide on the backstretch to press the pace, stalked outside into and on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, bid outside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly but could not get by. STONESIDE (IRE) also a bit slow to begin, went up inside to press the pace then stalked along the rail, bid again from the fence in the stretch and bested the others. CHARLIE'SBOYWINS had good early speed and dueled outside rivals, battled four wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SABOR AMARGO (CHI) between horses early, chased outside a rival or just off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRACE YOURSELVES pulled his way up to duel a bit off the rail to the stretch, was between horses in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MY MAN MORAN broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace throughout and did not rally.
