Footnotes

WARREN'S T. BAZE a bit slow into stride, moved up between horses leaving the backstretch then off the rail, went three wide leaving the turn then angled in, came out past midstretch and surged between horses under urging to get up late. ICE CREAM TRUCK chased outside then three deep on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well. FLY HIGH sent inside to duel for the lead, inched away a half mile out, remained clear on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back in midstretch and between rivals in deep stretch and edged a foe for the show. MARY HELEN'S STORM prompted the pace four wide then stalked three deep leaving the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside a rival on the bend, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain a short lead in midstretch and was edged late for third by that foe. GRAND GAMBLER dueled between horses then stalked between foes, continued inside on the turn and in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. ALSACE pulled his way between horses on the backstretch, angled in on the turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KARAIKAKIS angled in and stalked inside, came out on the turn and three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. TRIAL SPIN allowed to settle outside chasing the pace, went three and four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WHAT A JOURNEY broke slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. ALL THAT ROCKS dueled between horses then stalked inside, fell back along the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. JERRY FRANCO pulled early and stalked off the rail then between foes, continued between rivals leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and also weakened. SWEETDREAMSCOMETRU off a bit slowly, was sent along inside, saved ground chasing the pace and was not a threat. HANDSOME SAM hopped slightly then steadied at the start, pulled his way between horses to chase the pace, dropped back on the turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch. AWESOME KITE wide early, chased outside then three deep, dropped back and angled in outside a rival on the turn, found the inside in the stretch, also gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
