ROSSI RESERVE stalked the pace off the rail down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide, bid for the lead in midstretch, took command leaving the furlong marker and held to the wire. INNER GROOVE chased on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, came out at the top of the lane and rallied to gain the place. SCARY FAST broke in and bumped a rival at the start, pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, took a short lead in upper stretch and was outfinished through the final furlong. SECRET GENIUS was unhurried early, angled to the inside, came out at the top of the stretch, angled back towards the rail in the late going and improved her position. QUEEN OF THE HILL angled off the rail on the backstretch, went into the turn between horses, came into the stretch three wide and weakened in the stretch drive. PSALM SIXTEEN chased the pace three deep into the turn and weakened through the stretch drive. YUMA THURMAN was bumped at the start, stalked on the inside down the backstretch, fell back leaving the quarter pole and weakened in the lane. SUGAR SPICE dueled inside, fought back into the stretch and to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
