Footnotes

TOOMANYTOMATOES chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, inched away under good handling, lugged in a bit but proved best. STORMIN CEE'S had speed inside then saved ground stalking the pace, came out off heels and split rivals leaving the second turn, bid inside in midstretch, could not quite match the winner but continued willingly for the place. ALWAYS A CHANCE stalked three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and held third. PARTY WITH BRANDO angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. EVASIVE CHARMER had speed three deep then stalked outside a rival, bid alongside ROSES FOR JONI on the backstretch, put a head in front into the second turn, inched away leaving that turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened late. ROSES FOR JONI sped to the early lead between horses then inched away and angled in on the first turn, dueled inside on the backstretch and into the second turn, fell back some nearing the stretch and weakened.
