Footnotes

TOUGH 'N DANGEROUS went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, kicked clear under left handed urging in the stretch and held. ROCK OFF a bit slow to begin, went up inside to chase the pace, steadied in tight along the rail twice into the turn, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly. BABY BLAKE chased off the rail then outside, went three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. CHICS DIGTHESHARK sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside the winner on the backstretch, stalked just off the fence on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ERIC THE RAM chased a bit off the rail, went between horses into the turn then angled in, came out a bit into the stretch and did not rally. KEY REVERSAL between horses early, stalked just off the inside on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. CENTENARIO DE ORO broke a step slow and bobbled, went between horses midway on the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. IN HIGH REGARDS chased outside then three deep, split foes midway on the turn, angled in leaving the bend, found the rail in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
