Footnotes

VALERIA chased between horses then outside a rival, split foes on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. SPACECOAST angled in with speed between foes then stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch, could not match the winner but held second. TIZ A DAISY chased between rivals then a bit off the rail, continued inside into the turn, came out on the bend and three deep into the stretch and just missed the place. HELLO STORMY stalked the pace inside, came out for room in midstretch, split rivals in deep stretch and was outfinished. NO MISTRESS chased between rivals then outside a foe, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LILY'S TIZ had good early speed off the rail, angled in and dueled inside, fought back in midstretch, then weakened. FIVE TIMES chased between foes then outside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MALIBU BULLET angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TORRE ITALIANA between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. MIL ESTRELLAS bobbed after the start, chased three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and lacked a further response. CAN'TBEATTHEHEAT angled in and dueled outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. FIRE IN THE FOYER broke slowly, settled well off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, found the rail on the turn and was outrun. SHAMROCK BAY hopped slightly and was away behind the field, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and failed to menace.
