GO TO THE PULPIT pressed the pace between horses then outside a rival leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear under urging and proved best. WON WON OH FIVE pulled his way along three deep between horses into the first turn, stalked between foes then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and was clearly second best. DEAL' EM prompted the pace three deep most of the way until leaving the second turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and between horses in midstretch and just held third. JUAN'S TWIN saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and again in midstretch and just missed the show. SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, briefly inched away on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. DREAM CAUGHT broke out and a bit slowly and awkwardly, saved ground off the pace, came a bit out from the rail in the stretch and did not rally. QUIET COMMAND pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, chased three deep while trying to get out on the backstretch, lugged out and dropped back on the second turn to come well wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the drive.
