FREEWAYRACER four wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the backstretch and alongside a rival into and on the second turn and into the stretch, gained a short lead in the drive, inched away under urging past midstretch and won clear. **PUMPKIN PIE** saved ground stalking the pace, moved up on the second turn, came out into the stretch and gained the place. **BULL RUSH** sent inside to the early lead, duelled along the rail, fought back on the second turn and until past midstretch, could not match either of the top pair and just held third. **SMIL'N FROM ABOVE** five wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for the show. **BURTON'S ANGEL** four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. **DAZZLETOWN** angled in on the first turn and chased just off the rail, was in tight between foes into the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. **WARREN'S LOVER** settled inside then outside a rival chasing the pace, angled in again on the second turn and did not rally. **SILIC'S VALLEY** broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. **GLAMOUR MANOR** squeezed a bit at the start, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch then continued alongside a foe on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and weakened. **QUIET ADVICE** settled off the rail without early speed, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. **LOLLY GOGGIN** squeezed a bit at the start, moved up

between horses then dueled outside a rival, was between foes again on the backstretch, dropped back between foes into and on the second turn and gave way.
