KILLER BEAR settled outside then off the rail, went alongside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch, rallied under some left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and held. MACHO DORADO dueled four wide then three deep into and on the turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted in then out in deep stretch, fought back and continued willingly to the wire. MENSA HEAT bobbled slightly at the start, stalked off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch and edged a rival for third. HUNTSVILLE settled between horses then outside a rival, angled to the inside on the turn, came out in midstretch and just missed the show. LEGAL SEPARATION dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. RED SUN also dueled between horses, dropped back into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. MAUI MARK went up inside to duel for command, battled along the rail on the turn and weakened in the final furlong.
