**Footnotes**

CASEY'S CLEM a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage under urging along the rail past the eighth pole and won clear. YANA broke out a bit, stalked outside a rival, bid three deep into and on the turn, took the lead a quarter mile out, kicked clear in upper stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final furlong but clearly second best. MAGIC SPOT stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out three wide into the stretch and picked up the show. SINGLEINTHELAST chased outside a rival then just off the rail, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. EMOTIONAL DRIVE pulled her way along inside early, dueled from the rail, fought back on the turn, drifted out into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. MIA LUCCIA had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. REFLECTIVE GLORY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and did not rally. WARREN'S PURRFECT also broke a bit slowly, chased outside then three deep, angled in just off the inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn and weakened in the drive. PAPA'S DANCING a step slow to begin, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
