Footnotes

CAN'T TOPPER chased outside a rival on the backstretch, went into the turn three deep, moved up to engage the pacesetter in upper stretch, took command in midstretch, drew clear and held while drifting out some late. MAGIC MAMA chased on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, came out at the top of the stretch, rallied three deep in midstretch, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. NOT TO NOTTY sped to the early lead, set the pace on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, was engaged by the winner in upper stretch, could not go with that one and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. INDYCAT pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides with the pacesetter on the turn, came into the lane between horses and weakened. KISS MY SWISS stalked the pace off the rail down the backstretch and between horses into the turn, remained between foes in midstretch and weakened. LADY ROCHELLE chased the pace inside the winner on the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, remained near the wood in the lane and did not rally.
