**Footnotes**

ROCK THIS WAY sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside then inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear under left handed urging in the stretch and held. HURRICANE LAKE saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into the stretch, got through along the rail in midstretch, came out a bit and went willingly to the wire. ARRAIGNMENT stalked between horses for six furlongs, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. SO ELITE close up tracking the winner along the inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in midstretch and was edged for third. MR. CANDY BAR angled in and prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, was between horses past midstretch and weakened. SEATTLE RULER four wide into the first turn, chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. MEGASTAR chased between horses to the stretch and weakened. BRUSHBURN was in a good position stalking the pace three wide to the stretch, dropped back in the drive and gave way.
