Footnotes

SACRED OVATION sped to the early lead, inched away and set the pace off the rail, angled in on the turn, dueled inside, drifted out under left handed urging in the final furlong, fought back to a short lead a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. I'LL RUN THE SHOW had speed outside the winner then stalked off the rail, bid again leaving the turn, put a head in front in midstretch, was floated out in the final furlong and edged. WARRIOR JAMES chased between foes then three deep to the stretch, angled inward in late stretch and finished with interest. BAY GAMBLER between horses early, chased four wide then three deep leaving the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and did not rally. HILLCREST AVENUE broke a bit slowly, moved up inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WARREN'S JOE T. broke a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail then angled to the inside, saved ground on the turn, waited briefly then got through inside in the stretch and was not a threat. GAUL settled a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. MENTALIZE broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled off the rail, angled in alongside a rival leaving the turn and did not rally. RADAR AHEAD also a bit slow to begin, chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the hill, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. FLEW FLICKER was in a good position chasing the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, weakened in the drive. TAYLOR'S JOURNEY well placed stalking the pace inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the final furlong and also weakened. DANI'S BIRTHDAY chased the pace outside then off the rail, angled in on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
