Footnotes

AMULAY sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set all the pace along the inside, inched away on the second turn, drew clear under urging in the stretch and proved best. ENGLISH PUDDIN saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch then angled in and outfinished a rival for the place. PURE BLUSH four wide into the first turn, chased three deep then between horses, angled to the inside on the second turn,

came out into the stretch and was edged late for second. PAWN SHOP broke a bit slowly, chased inside then between horses leaving the backstretch, split rivals on the second turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. PSALM SIXTEEN five wide into the first turn, chased four wide then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside on the second turn, remained along the rail in the stretch and lacked a rally. HIP a bit slow to begin, angled in just off the rail, split horses on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. RACHELS BELLE stalked between horses then just off the rail, came out into the stretch and weakened. BOO WHO WHO chased between rivals on the first turn and backstretch, found the inside into the second turn and did not rally. PLAZARITA pulled between horses early then chased three deep to the stretch and lacked a further response. TRIBAL RAIN four wide early, stalked three deep, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. WARRENS CHINA DOLL pulled her way between horses to chase the pace, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
