FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD AND UPWARD. Closed by subscription of \$400 each on or before Friday, August 10, 2012 which should accompany the nomination with 32 nominations. (No sustaining payments)Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Thursday, November 15, 2012 by payment of \$5,000 each, which should accompany the nomination, of which \$4,000 is refundable if the nominee is entered and does not draw into the body of the race or if the nominee is not entered and a veterinarian certificate is produced indicating the horse is unfit to run. Closed with 3. All nominees to pay \$2,000 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start. Gross purse \$250,000 of which \$150,000 to be paid to the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner and trainer.

DATA LINK stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail into and on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and won clear under left handed urging. ULTIMATE EAGLE broke alertly and sped to the early lead then came off the rail approaching the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away again on the second turn, kicked clear into the stretch, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. DOUBLES PARTNER saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and finished well. JERANIMO chased between horses then outside a rival, went between foes again on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. TEMPLE'S DOOR pulled his way along three deep, was bumped and fanned out into the first turn, tugged and steadied nearing midway on the backstretch, stalked outside or off the rail, angled in for the second turn and lacked the needed rally. TALE OF A CHAMPION also pulled and bumped a rival when fanned out some into the first turn, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. INTERACTION (ARG) a bit slow to begin, settled three deep then off the rail, went three wide again on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the drive.
