DEPRECIABLE had speed outside rivals then angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear under urging in the stretch and held on gamely. MR. CANDY BAR pulled some and steadied into the first turn, stalked between foes then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, came out some in the drive and edged rivals for the place. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) steadied when crowded at the start, settled a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well for the show. YOMYBATO settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and had a late bid between rivals on the line. TAMA COUNTY broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and also finished with some interest between horses. LIBERTY CAP saved ground stalking the pace throughout and lacked the needed late kick. MAJOR MAGIC broke in a bit, stalked early then pressed the pace outside the winner, fell back some in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened some late. ROMEO ROYALE four wide into the first turn, chased three deep then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HUSBAND'S FOLLY a bit slow to begin, stalked three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and weakened.
