Footnotes

STONE HOT wide early, angled to the inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, slipped through inside to bid for the lead past midstretch, gained the lead a sixteenth out and won clear. WAR FACE stalked outside or off the rail and five wide into the turn, continued three deep on the bend and into the

stretch, bid outside a rival, took the lead past the eighth pole, could not match the winner late but held second. RUNSTEVIERUN saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. NATE DAWG settled off the rail, steadied sharply at the fallen rider into the turn, angled in leaving the turn, found the rail in the stretch and just missed third. FREE TIME dueled between horses then three deep on the turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch, fought back inside the runner-up in midstretch and between foes a sixteenth out, then weakened. HOMBRE HUGHES chased between horses or outside, went six wide into the turn, angled in off the rail into the stretch and lacked a rally. BLING CHA BLING bumped at the start, chased between horses, came out three deep into the stretch when in tight off heels entering the lane and lacked the needed rally. GEORGIA'S FRIEND dueled between horses, was in a bit tight between foes into the stretch and weakened. RIO GOOD stalked between horses then outside, was kept five wide early on the turn by the riderless horses, angled in off the rail and also weakened. ITHOUGHTIPAIYOU had speed between horses then dueled inside, fought back on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and also weakened. SPARKLE JOEL prompted the pace four wide, took an awkward step and lost the rider early on the turn. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident into the turn before ruling SPARKLE JOEL was the cause of his own trouble.
