Footnotes

COYOTE ROAD broke inward, sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, inched away leaving the turn and drew clear in the stretch under a tap of the whip on the shoulder and a strong hand ride. QUICK CENIZAS stalked outside foes then alongside a rival on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and was second best. BANDINI'S ROGUE chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, angled in for the turn, came out around a rival into the stretch and picked up the show. WARREN'S BUGLER settled between horses then outside a rival, went three wide into and out of the turn and lacked the needed rally. MR. DAY TRIPPER broke outward, was between rivals early, stalked outside a foe then just off the rail to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. DEMAND SUCCESS sent between horses early, angled in and stalked inside but weakened in the drive. ROARK steadied when squeezed at the start, settled outside or off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. ON I WIN a step slow to begin, settled just off the rail, came out when in a bit tight nearing midway on the turn, entered the stretch three deep and was not a threat. RAISIN BRAN chased a bit off the rail then between horses, steadied briefly when shuffled back early on the turn, angled to the inside and weakened. FREEDOM BLUES saved ground off the pace, came out when in tight off heels nearing midway on the turn, continued just off the inside into the stretch and failed to menace.
