FIT TO RULE angled in nearing the first turn and stalked inside, bid along the rail leaving the backstretch to gain the lead into the second turn, inched away on that bend, kicked clear a quarter mile out, widened under left handed urging and proved much the best under steady handling late. TORUK MAKTO four wide into the first turn, angled in and chased off the rail then inside, moved up leaving the second turn, came out between horses into the stretch and picked up the place. VANTAGE POINT broke a bit slowly, stalked between horses then outside a rival, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response but bested the others. BIPARTISAN broke outward, was in a bit tight behind the winner into the first turn, stalked inside then just off the rail, continued along the fence on the second turn and weakened. MR T BIRD between horses early, stalked three deep, dropped back on the second turn, had the rider lose the whip nearing the quarter pole, drifted four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive. MIKEY T five wide in the run to the first turn, took the lead and angled over, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled outside the winner into the second turn, dropped back between foes leaving that turn and gave way. NIAGARA FALLS broke slowly, jumped shadows in the early going to fall well back, dropped farther back on the backstretch, was always outrun and eased in the stretch.
