DEN'S LEGACY stalked the pace inside, waited briefly in upper stretch then got through along the fence to take the lead nearing the eighth pole, inched clear under urging and held. RISING LEGEND (GB) unhurried a bit off the rail then inside to the second turn, came out leaving that bend and three deep into the stretch, came out again and closed willingly. SHINING COPPER reluctant to load, chased three deep on the first turn then outside on the backstretch, went between horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished with interest. ONE FIRM CAT in tight inside into the first turn, went between horses on the backstretch, split rivals on the second turn, angled to the rail into the stretch, came out for room in midstretch, was in tight again off heels a sixteenth out and went between rivals late. TREE OF LIFE pulled between horses then steadied when forced out into the first turn, settled outside, went three wide into the second turn, angled in some into the stretch, split horses past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. UNDER REVIEW rank between horses and steadied into the first turn, came out leaving that turn, chased outside then three wide on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. COUNTING DAYS stalked outside then three deep, bid three wide leaving the second turn, came out some into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. CHRISTOPHER STREET between horses early, stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, was between horses leaving that turn, came out between foes some into the stretch and also weakened in the final furlong.

DANCIN UPSIDE DOWN sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, fought back leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, was between foes nearing the eighth pole and weakened. EKAHI pulled between foes and was in tight into the first turn, chased just off the rail then inside, dropped back along the fence on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
