SIEMPRE ESPERANZA settled off the rail then outside the runner-up, came three wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, gained the advantage past the eighth pole, kicked clear under urging and proved best. SECRET GENIUS angled in and raced unhurried along the inside, moved up along the rail leaving the turn, waited momentarily then slipped through inside into the stretch and rallied up the fence to gain the place late. QUIET SUNSHINE bobbed slightly at the start, prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival leaving the turn, took a short lead, battled between horses in midstretch, was three wide again in deep stretch and outfinished a foe for the show. VAADKA LOGIC had good early speed and dueled between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and in the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final furlong and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. TWO FEATHERS went up inside to duel for the lead, dropped back under urging leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, continued under urging in midstretch then was eased late while drifting out.
