PROCUREMENT chased three deep then outside a rival, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up in deep stretch and proved best. FURY KAPCORI sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, duled from the rail on the backstretch and second turn, inched away again under urging in midstretch and held on well but could not quite match the winner late. DEN'S LEGACY stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and edged rivals for the show. AVARE stalked outside a rival then bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and second turn, battled between horses leaving that turn and into the stretch and was edged for third. PURE LOYALTY pulled and steadied along the inside into the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. OUTSIDE NASHVILLE also pulled and steadied in the run to the first turn, chased a bit off the rail then inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was in tight in midstretch, came out for room and went four wide on the wire. JUST WIN BABY reluctant to load, chased between horses or outside a rival, continued between foes on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
