QUAINTLY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. WARREN'S GOT GAME saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and closed willingly to just miss. GLOWING SPIRIT (BRZ) took the early lead outside a rival then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back when challenged on the backstretch and second turn, weakened some in the final furlong but held third. SPLENDIFEROUS MOON angled in approaching the first turn and chased inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SALEZ (IRE) pulled early, went three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, was between horses into the second turn, continued alongside a foe leaving that turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. REMARKABLE MOON chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
