**Footnotes**

CAYAMBE dueled three deep then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, inched away and angled in on the turn, opened up in the stretch and held under left handed urging. STREETS OF HEAVEN stalked outside then four wide, continued three deep on the turn then off the rail leaving the bend and was clearly second best. MAX COOPER dueled between horses then stalked into the turn, split rivals on the bend, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in through the drive but outfinished a rival for third. HALF DOME DUDE settled inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, advanced five wide on the turn and four wide into the stretch, also drifted in some and was outfinished for the show. SCOFIELD BARRACKS broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then inside, split horses leaving the turn and lacked the needed rally. CLASSY LION chased between horses, went four wide leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. EL PITUCON (ARG) chased off the rail then between horses, dropped back into the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. BIG BAD BROWN stalked off the rail then between horses, steadied while weakening between foes leaving the turn and dropped back. OL'DOGTOWN had good early speed and dueled inside, stalked into and on the turn and gave way in the stretch.
