Footnotes

FLASHY DELIGHT chased a bit off the rail then moved up inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn, bid three wide into the stretch, gained the lead, inched away in midstretch, kicked clear under urging and held. FIESTA EXPRESS four wide early, settled outside a rival then inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, split horses past midstretch and finished well. MISS COMMUNICATION sent inside to vie for the lead then stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, took a short advantage into the stretch, was between foes nearing midstretch and just held third. TOLUCA three deep early, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between horses at the wire. MISS SPEED DATING angled in and settled inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor share three wide on the line. WARREN'S MO MONEY stumbled at the start, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. HEART OF A MADAM had speed between horses then angled in on the first turn, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. AROUND THE TWIG three deep early, dueled outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back between horses on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
