Footnotes

SILENTIO chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, found the rail into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, gained a slim advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed between foes under some late urging. SUMMER FRONT settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the backstretch, went three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, bid three wide in midstretch and continued gamely to the wire. WINNING PRIZE (ARG) had speed four wide then angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away again on the second turn, fought back along the rail through the final furlong and also went willingly to the end. BIG BANE THEORY chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between foes leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued just off the fence into the stretch and was outfinished. BIO PRO between horses early, stalked three deep then bid three wide on the backstretch, tracked the leader alongside a foe on the second turn, was between rivals again nearing midstretch and weakened some in the final furlong. MY BEST BROTHER pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, steadied briefly while being shuffled back into the second turn, came out nearing the stretch and weakened. BRIGHT THOUGHT also pulled between horses then stalked off the rail, bid between foes on the backstretch, was in a bit tight into the second turn, fell back and angled in on that turn and gave way in the stretch.
