Footnotes

SCORPION TIME came off the rail on the first turn, stalked the pace just off the fence, split horses on the second turn, came out in the drive and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. LAST MEMORIES chased outside the winner or off the rail, moved up three and four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage, inched clear and held on well but was caught on the line. HYADES broke slowly, saved ground off the pace, moved up on the second turn and into the stretch, came out under urging in upper stretch, split rivals while the rider lost the whip in midstretch and continued willingly toward the inside. GOLD MEDALLION had speed outside then took the lead on the first turn, dueled outside a rival, stalked off the fence on the second turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and weakened. DEADLY CATCH sped to the early lead inside then pulled and steadied sharply for a couple strides into the first turn, dueled along the rail, regained the lead leaving the backstretch, inched away on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. ACHAK (IRE) allowed to settle and angled in just off the rail early, went outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back under urging on the second turn and gave way.
