JAYCITO a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along inside then drifted out leaving the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, lugged out into and on the second turn to enter the stretch five wide, bid outside, gained the advantage past the eighth pole, inched away under some urging in deep stretch and proved best. TRES BORRACHOS angled in and settled off the rail chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, took a short lead outside foes nearing midstretch, fought back inside the winner to deep stretch and held second. FLY LEXIS FLY broke a bit slowly, angled in on the first turn and settled inside, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well for the show. GOLDEN ITIZ saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and weakened. BLUESKIESRAINBOWS had good early speed and dueled inside, gained the advantage on the second turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. REGULUS was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and also weakened. GUIDOPANZINI had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, dropped back between horses into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
