FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. Closed by subscription of \$400 each on or before Wednesday, August 7, 2013 which should accompany the nomination. (No sustaining payments , Closed with 49) Late nominations , for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Friday, October 4, 2013 by payment of \$2,000 each, which should accompany the nomination. (Closed with 4). Late nominations, for horses not previously nominated, may be made on or before Thursday, November 14, 2013 by payment of \$5,000 each, which should accompany the nomination, of which \$4,000 is refundable if the nominee is entered and does not draw into the body of the race or if nominee is not entered and a veterinarian certificate is produced indicating the horse is unfit to run. (closed with 4) All nominees to pay \$2,000 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start. Gross purse \$250,000 of which \$150,000 to be paid to the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner and trainer.

SEEK AGAIN angled in leaving the chute and settled a bit off the rail, found the inside into the second turn, cut the corner into the stretch, bid inside in midstretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and proved best under urging. ADMIRAL KITTEN unhurried and angled in to settle off the pace just out from the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. AMEN KITTEN allowed to settle off the pace and angled in leaving the chute, raced unhurried just off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, angled out again for a path in midstretch and rallied willingly. GERVINHO stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award between foes late. ROOKIE SENSATION had speed three deep then edged away and angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch, inched away again a quarter mile out, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, battled outside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but gave ground grudgingly to the others. JACK MILTON chased outside a rival then three deep into and on the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in the drive and

lacked the needed rally. INFINITE MAGIC stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the backstretch, also went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DRY SUMMER had speed between foes then stalked between rivals, continued outside a foe leaving the backstretch and between horses again on the second turn and weakened. IRISH SURF four wide in the chute, stalked three deep, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, tracked between horses leaving that turn and also weakened.
