CLOUDY MOON dueled outside a rival, inched away into the stretch, drifted in a bit from the whip in midstretch then kicked away under left handed urging. JADE WITH ENVY stalked outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and was clearly second best. SOPHIE'S SECRET sped to the early lead, dueled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came a bit off the fence and weakened in the stretch but held third. LIFE IS A STONE saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked a further response. BLAZING DANCER chased outside then alongside a rival leaving the backstretch, continued off the rail on the turn and did not rally. MINT TWIST hopped a bit in a slow start, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. TRULY AWESOME broke a bit slowly, settled toward the inside then a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and gave way.
