Footnotes

MARKET NOTES went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away past midway on the turn, drew off in the stretch, drifted out from the whip in deep stretch and won clear under steady handling late. RAMBLING HOUSE prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and gained the place outside foes late. REPS AND WARRANTS a bit slow to begin and bumped, was sent inside to chase the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the turn and into the stretch and split rivals in deep stretch. ILLYBILLY BOY chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and was outfinished for a minor award along the rail. ZNELLE chased outside then three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the

needed late kick. CAPO chased outside then four wide, angled in on the turn, swung out three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. BLACK TIE broke in a bit, was sent between horses then chased off the rail or outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. TOP HOT ROD off a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. NO LONGER BLUE broke in and bumped a rival in a slow start, saved ground off the pace, continued inside in the stretch and failed to menace. SHORT SWORD dueled between horses then outside the winner, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. GLIDING LOVE had speed four wide then stalked outside, fell back and angled in outside a rival on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
