Footnotes

WILLYCONKER (IRE) pulled early then stalked inside, split horses leaving the second turn, bid inside the leader to gain the advantage in midstretch and won clear under urging. LUMBERYARD JACK settled inside then a bit off the rail, went around a rival into the stretch, came out in midstretch and gained the place late three deep on the wire. STONEY FLEECE had speed between horses then stalked inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some in the lane and split horses on the line. POLYTECHNICIEN pulled hard between horses then stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter into the second turn to gain the lead, inched clear leaving that turn, fought back outside the winner in midstretch, then could not match that one in the final furlong and was outfinished late for a minor award. HAWK'S EYES (BRZ) chased three deep then outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EXTENSIVE pulled between horses then stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. DIRTY SWAGG had speed four wide then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled into the second turn, dropped back leaving that turn and weakened.
