Footnotes

ANYTHINGSCOOKIN sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, responded when rivals loomed and came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in a bit while inching away again in midstretch, kicked clear under urging and held. BIO PRO a step slow to begin, stalked between horses, was in a bit tight into the turn, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and got up three deep for the place in late stretch. MARV pulled his way up inside into a bit of a tight spot on the backstretch, saved ground stalking the pace, waited some on the turn, tried to go through inside the winner in midstretch but steadied when in tight again but continued willingly late to hold third. ONLY THE GOLD four wide early, stalked three deep, bid three wide into the stretch, had the winner slip away again while outside MARV in midstretch and weakened late. STAUFFENBERG between foes early, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and had no further response. BOB GRECO settled off the inside then alongside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run through midstretch but made no change when they ruled there never was sufficient room for MARV to get through inside the winner.
